



Check & Connect in Florida

The Florida State Personnel Development Grant is working with 16 school districts in Florida to implement the Strategic Instruction Model (SIM), and/or Check and Connect. Because schools and districts that are not currently targeted by SPDG have expressed interest in implementing Check & Connect, the SPDG has developed this document to provide information on resources and supports that are available to those schools and districts.

Training Availability

• The SPDG provides two types of training; a one-day Preparation and Implementation session and a two-day Mentor training. The Preparation and Implementation session is targeted at school and district leadership teams. This session walks the team through an 11-step planning process to prepare for implementation at a specific local site. Mentor training prepares the individual mentors to implement the Check and Connect model. SPDG offers this training in locations throughout the state. There is no cost for the training for non- SPDG schools. The training is on a space-available basis.
